Know the Facts About HPV for Your Children

- **Both males and females can get a virus called HPV, or human papillomavirus.**
- **Certain types of HPV can cause cervical cancer in females. Other types of HPV can cause genital warts in both males and females.**
- **Exposure can happen with any kind of adolescent experimentation that involves genital contact with someone who has HPV — intercourse isn't necessary.**
- **Many people who have HPV do not even know it, because the virus often has no signs or symptoms.**
